



## Wicks Green/Monks Alley Conservation Area

Our request to designate the Wicks Green Lane and Monks Alley area as a first Conservation Area for Binfield, is now the subject of a Public Consultation which is running until February 28th, 2011.

**Conservation Area Status will give this area extra protection from unwelcome development and traffic.**



**Bracknell Forest Council** tested our request for the designation of Wicks Green and Monks Alley as a Conservation Area by seeking an independent opinion from a **Principal Heritage Consultant**. He concluded that:

*“The area has well-defined special character which includes a number of listed buildings as well as a number of buildings of local interest which it would be desirable to preserve. We therefore, fully support the designation of a conservation area.”*

There will be those who will object to this proposal because they want to build in the area.

Therefore, we need your help to present a balanced view from all residents of Binfield village.
